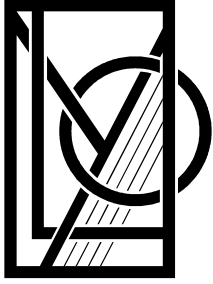

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Member Rules

Accepted by the LYCO committee as a document November 2007

These rules are to be read as forming part of the Launceston Youth and Community Orchestra Inc Constitution. All members must indicate acceptance of these Rules as part of their annual membership application.

General:

1. Members should pay all prescribed fees in the time frame set by the committee.
2. All members are required to complete an annual application for membership to be approved by the committee.
3. New members should submit their application for membership after attending three rehearsals.
4. The committee may refuse any membership application without explanation (ref: LYCO Constitution).
5. Members who are hiring instruments from the LYCO should pay an annual hiring fee as prescribed by the committee.
6. All members on accepting membership take responsibility for preparing their instrumental parts to the best of their ability.
7. All members should be aware that the LYCO is a combined group. This places an extra responsibility on adults to maintain exemplary behaviour at all times.
8. If any member has any issues with any of these rules or with any other member or situation, this should be reported to the executive committee for resolution.

Sheet Music:

1. All sheet music provided remains the property of the LYCO and should be maintained in good condition and returned to the LYCO librarian/s at the conclusion of each year or when no longer required.
2. Any member who leaves the LYCO/Piccolo Strings before the end of the year should ensure that all sheet music is returned.
3. Any editorial markings made on the music by members should be in pencil.

Rehearsals:

1. Members should endeavour to arrive at rehearsals earlier than the advertised starting time in order to set up and tune ready to play at the starting time.
2. Members should assist where possible with the setting up of the orchestra places prior to rehearsals and with disassembling after rehearsals.

Uniform:

1. All members are required to purchase the LYCO uniform (T-shirt) and wear this for public performances as requested.
