I What to bring

1.1 Everyone

- Sleeping bag or sheets and bedding
- Pillow case (pillows are provided)
- Towel
- Toiletries and personal items
- Warm clothing and waterproof coat (weather can be unpredictable!)
- Suitable casual clothing for everyday wear

1.2 Musicians

- Musical instrument (arrange your own insurance for your instrument if you want it)
- Music stand (clearly labelled with your name)
- Printouts of all music that we asked you to download

1.3 Security

We take all care for belongings, but no responsibility. This includes musical instruments. We have never had a security problem at camp. We suggest all unnecessary valuables, including money and electronic equipment, are left at home. We do have a lockable office for special items. However, this should be for long-term storage only as our staff cannot provide frequent access to things like mobile phones.

2 Getting There

The address for Camp Clayton is **41 Clayton Road**. The turn-off to the camp is clearly marked on the Bass Highway between Turner's Beach and Ulverstone. Obey all speed limits and parking instructions while driving within Camp Clayton grounds.

3 Camp Rules

All campers must abide by the **Camp Clayton Rules**. These are attached to the application form, and you agree to it when you sign page 1. Our camps have always provided a relaxed, supportive and pleasant learning experience and campers must respect the rights of all others to enjoy this to the full.

4 Accommodation

Accommodation is shared unless there are exceptional circumstances. You will be allocated to a cabin/room at registration. We will make every effort to place friends together in cabins as requested and to meet any other accommodation needs. Children under 18 will be accommodated with the adult responsible for them during the camp. Children under 6 stay free.

5 First Aid

Camp Clayton first aid facilities are available for use during the camp. See Virginia if these are needed.

6 Music

The music will be similar to that played at previous LYCO Winter Workshops and camps. For examples, visit the galleries linked from www.lyco.org.au/wow.

Once the music is chosen, it will also be announced on the WOW website. Any music that is in the public domain will be made available to applicants for practice before the camp.

7 Timetable

Sunday (July 3rd)

The open rehearsal ends at 3:00pm and all campers need to leave the site by 4:00pm.
