

# Supervision of Children at Camp



## Terms:

- **unaccompanied child:**
  - any child over the age of 11yrs and
    - whose parents are not attending Camp and/or
    - who is staying in a Lodge under the supervision of a Camp Parent
- **accompanied child:** any child sharing accommodation with a parent
- **Camp Parent:** volunteer assigned by the RSSC Management Team to supervise unaccompanied children for the duration of the Camp
- **Orchestra Parent:** volunteer assigned by the RSSC Management Team to supervise the safety and wellbeing of both children and adults during orchestra rehearsals
- **Lodge:** the name given to the dormitory-style accommodation at Camp Clayton
- **Scheduled Activity:**
  - orchestra rehearsals and sectional
  - ensembles/electives
  - afternoon/evening activities

## Unaccompanied Child:

- minimum age: 11yrs at the start of the Camp
- each child will be accommodated in a Lodge with other children of a similar age
- each Lodge is supervised by a Camp Parent
- Camp Parents are responsible for the safety and wellbeing of the child outside of Scheduled Activities

## Accompanied Child:

- parents are responsible for the supervision of their children at all times outside of Scheduled Activities
- this includes taking their children to and from Scheduled Activities
- all children under the age of 11yrs at the start of Camp must be accompanied by a parent

## Parents attending Camp whose child will be accommodated in Lodges:

- parents attending Camp may choose to accommodate their child over the age of 11yrs in a Lodge
- parents must be aware that it will be the responsibility of the Camp Parent to supervise the safety and wellbeing of your child for the duration of their stay
- this includes setting the bed time, housekeeping, etc
- parents are not allowed to enter the Lodges
- parents must not take their children off-site without the letting the Camp Parents know in advance
- Camp Parents will contact the parent at any point with any concern
- parents may discuss any concerns regarding their child with the Camp Parents at any point

## Supervisors of both accompanied and unaccompanied children during Scheduled Activities:

- orchestra rehearsals:
  - an Orchestra Parent assigned to each orchestra
  - parents accompanying their own children if they are also playing in the same orchestra
- sectionals/ensembles/electives:
  - tutors
  - parents accompanying their own children if they are also playing in the same sectionals
- afternoon and evening activities:
  - Activity Supervisor
  - parents accompanying their own children as desired
