### Information

## Note that Camp Clayton is a Nut-Free venue

#### What to Bring

- **Sheet to cover your mattress**
- Sheets and bedding, or sleeping bag (beds are either single or Queen)
- **Pillow** and pillow cases (pillows are no longer provided unless as part of linen hire)
- Towels
- **OR** if you are staying in Camp Clayton accommodation bed-linen and towels can be hired (see application form)
- Toiletries and personal items
- Warm clothing and waterproof coat (weather can be unpredictable!)

#### Accommodation

- Rooms will be allocated at Registration
- Please note there are **no single rooms at Camp Clayton**
- There are facilities for tents and motor-homes on the Camp Clayton site

#### Meals

- Any special diet or food allergy must be indicated on the application form as well as Camp Clayton's own on-line form (details on application form)
- All campers will be assigned to serve food and/or tidy up after meals. (see Roster in Dining Room)

#### Visitors

- Visitors are not allowed onsite at any time apart from to drop people off at the start of camp, to pick people up at the end of camp, or to attend the open rehearsal/play-through on Sunday afternoon
